Dear Queen of All Saints' Families,

As we set our clocks to “fall back” this Sunday for the end of Daylight Savings, we are full speed ahead at school!

Tomorrow we will celebrate Halloween (All Hallows Eve) with several festivities including our annual Halloween costume parade. Join us on the schoolyard at 11:00 a.m. for the parade and Halloween fun. As this is meant to be a fun day for the children, students are invited to wear their costumes to school with the following guidelines:

Costumes should be appropriate for Catholic elementary school; for safety purposes students must wear their school shoes with their costume; no gory, bloody, or costumes that are suggestive; students should not bring accessories such as canes, sticks, or weapon-like items to school; masks that impede sight may not be worn. Note, a mask worn with free dress is not a costume.

The teachers and administration reserve the right to deem costumes inappropriate for school, so please assist your child in abiding by the guidelines so a fun time may be had by all. Halloween is not a free dress day. Students who are not dressed in costume should wear their PE or regular uniform to school.

We celebrate All Saints Day on Friday, November 1 at 8:30 a.m. Saints Mass, where the classroom “Saints” process into church prior to the beginning of Mass. In the afternoon, we will have our very first Saints Wax Museum. Saints will be stationed in the hallways, and the students will visit each station to learn about the different saints. You are welcome to join us for Mass and the Wax Museum.

Lessons from the Gospel(Sermon 4 Kids)

"The Son of Man came to find lost people and save them." Luke 19:10 (ICB)

How tall are you? I can remember when I was the age of some of you. I wasn't very tall. Many times I had trouble reaching things that were up on a high shelf. Sometimes, I would have to stand on a footstool or pull up a chair to stand on to reach what I wanted. If there was a tall person sitting in front

of me at the movie, I would have to lean from side to side to see around them or sit on my knees to see over them.

Today's Bible lesson is about a man who was very short. His name is Zacchaeus. One day, he climbed into a tree so he could see Jesus speaking to crowds. When Jesus came by and saw Zacchaeus in the tree, Jesus looked up at him and called him by name.

Jesus knew his name! And Jesus knows your name. Jesus said, "Zacchaeus! Come down quickly. I am going to be a guest in your home today." And Zacchaeus took Jesus to his house. The people could not believe that Jesus would go to the home of a man like that!

Jesus changed Zacchaeus. And Zacchaeus said, "I am going to give half of all that I own to the poor, and if I have cheated anybody out of anything, I will pay back four times the amount.

Jesus forgave Zacchaeus and said, "Today, salvation has come to this house. For the Son of Man came to seek and save those who are lost."

Jesus knew Zacchaeus' name. And he knew everything Zacchaeus had ever done. When Zacchaeus met Jesus, his life was changed. It doesn't matter if you are short or tall, Jesus knows your name, too, and Jesus knows everything about you.

*Heavenly Father, we know that when we meet Jesus, it will be a life-changing experience.
Thank you that Jesus knows our name and loves us. In Jesus' name, Amen.*
