Dear Queen of All Saints Families,

Mr. Bill and I had a very productive phone meeting with our Project Manager, Sylvia Martinez, who is overseeing the construction that will take place during the summer. We had intended on having a Town Hall meeting on March 26th to update you on the scope of the project, but with procedures put in place to limit large gatherings due to Covid-19, we will need to find an alternate way to communicate the many upgrades that are being considered.

One area that we must focus on immediately is the need to fundraise the additional \$10,000 we need to go toward our \$80,000 commitment to Shea. In our last Advisory School Board and PACE meeting, the idea of asking all school families to sell two boxes of chocolates to contribute \$60/family to the project was unanimously agreed upon. I brought up the idea at the parish council meeting, and two council members asked to purchase three cases of chocolate to help us raise funds! Each family will be receiving a letter that will ask for a 2-box commitment and the payment process, or the option of donating \$60 without selling chocolate. Look for that letter to come home with your child's Report Card. I appreciate your partnership as we move forward with this amazing and generous gift that has been granted to the school.

Lessons for the Sunday Gospels- The Woman at the Well

Jesus answered, "Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again, but whoever drinks the water I give him will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give him will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life." John 4: 13-14 (NIV)

Whether you play sports, or just play hard on the playground or in your neighborhood, you know that when you're exercising, it's very important to stay hydrated. The question is: What kind of liquids should you drink?

Ordinary water is a good choice, but when you go to the store, the shelves are full of all kinds of sports drinks, energy drinks, and flavored water. Sometimes it's hard to know what's best. All the advertisements make choosing even more confusing.

In all the claims made by sports drinks, not once have they ever claimed that if you would drink their product, you would NEVER be thirsty again. If somebody had something that would do that, they would really have something, wouldn't they? Well, Jesus claimed to have that very thing!

One day Jesus was walking through a town in Samaria. He was hot and tired so he sat down beside a well to rest. A woman came to the well to get some water, and Jesus asked her if she would give him a drink. The woman was surprised that Jesus spoke to her because Jews would not usually speak to Samaritans.

Jesus told her that He could give her living water!

She didn't understand what He was talking about so she said, "You don't even have anything to get water in, how can you give me living water?"

Then Jesus said, "Whoever drinks from the water from this well will be thirsty again, but whoever drinks the water I give him will never thirst again."

Wow! Water that would satisfy your thirst so you would never be thirsty again! Jesus wasn't talking about our thirst for water from a well. He was talking about our thirst for God. The Bible teaches us that we have a thirst in our heart for the living God. And that is a thirst that only Jesus can satisfy. So when we have Jesus in our heart, He satisfies our thirst for God and we will never thirst again! Jesus is life! Drink it up!

Dear Lord, You have given us Jesus, the Living Water. May we drink of Your Living Water so we will never thirst again. In Jesus' name, amen.
