Remember Used Uniforms? Yes!

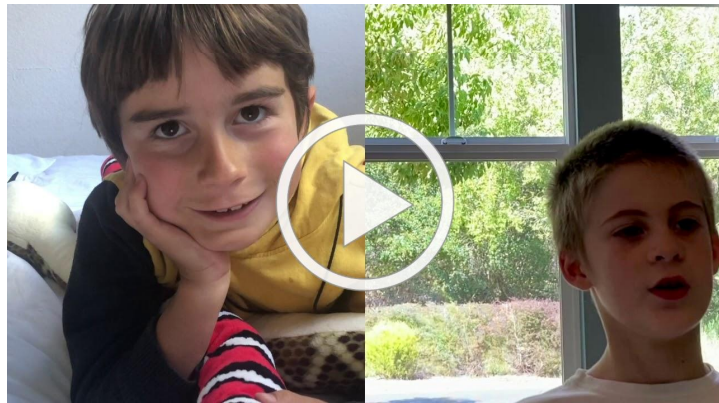

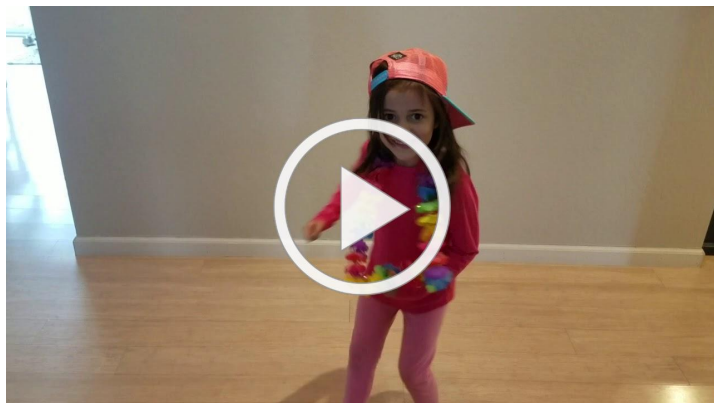
