Board Update

The Board met via Zoom on Wednesday, May 27, where the main order of business was discussing and approving the operating budget for the year. The Board approved the budget, recognizing that costs and revenues may be impacted as we navigate the COVID-19 pandemic, and agreed to be flexible to adjustments as needed. In addition, progress on the head of school transition was reviewed, as well as highlights from the COVID-19 force, Governance, and other committees. PLEASE if possible, hold off purchasing your uniforms and consider supporting our PA sale!

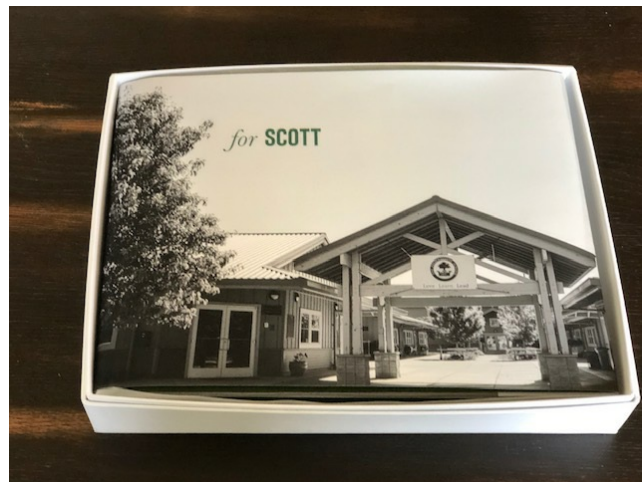
