Drop Off and Pick Up

The rule of thumb is to go with the flow and move forward as far as possible. If you are picking up multiple students, please park on the black top and gather all of the kids. If the front of the school is backed up and not moving, please proceed to the black top and turn around and join the queue. **PLEASE DO NOT PARK ALONG THE SOUTH ENTRANCE OF THE CAMPUS - IT BACKS TRAFFIC UP INTO BROADWAY AND MAKES YOUR FELLOW PARENTS CRANKY. PLEASE USE THE CROSSWALK IN THE FRONT LOT AND DO NOT CUT THROUGH THE GRASS,** People might be surprised and it is dangerous.
