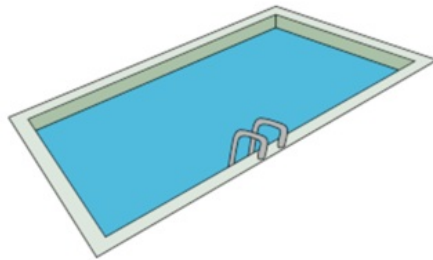

Dear Parents, Faculty and Staff:

As mentioned previously, the Board will be reporting on its work conducted at their monthly meetings. The report below, follows our meeting on September 11, 2018.

The Development Committee reported that the Presentation Fund kick-off has begun and will run through the month of September. The committee for the Imagine Event is in the beginning stages of planning.

The Finance Committee presented the actual budget for 2017-2018 and the operating budget for 2018-2019, which was approved by the Board at their May meeting.

The Board, along with the Head of School, began its initial efforts towards formulating the school's five-year strategic financial plan. This financial plan is part of the Board's work to meet the financial health and stability goals of the 2016 Strategic Plan. The Board has asked the Finance Committee to provide data and analysis to aid the Board in their strategic financial plan.
