

Applying for Grant and Financial Assistance

Any family wishing to be considered for financial assistance must complete the online FACTS Grant and Aid application. A new application must be submitted each school year. Submission of a financial aid application does not guarantee financial assistance.

Saint Elizabeth School has partnered with two organizations for tuition assistance: Family Aid - Catholic Education (FACE) and BASIC Fund, and uses FACTS to assist with information gathering and the assessment of tuition assistance. FACTS will provide an independent and reasonable assessment of the ability of each family to pay tuition. FACTS does not make any decisions about recipients and the amounts of financial aid awarded.

Applications open January 1,2020 Application deadline is March 15, 2020

In completing your FACTS application, you are also eligible to apply to Family Aid - Catholic Education (FACE). In order to be considered, you will need to check a box to authorize FACE to receive your application. FACE provides need-based tuition grants to students who attend Catholic schools in the Diocese of Oakland.



Applications open January 1, 2020

March 18, 2020 - Deadline for new student applications (this includes siblings of renewing students).

The BASIC Fund is a privately funded organization providing partial-tuition scholarships to low-income families across the Bay Area, helping them afford the cost of tuition at the private school of their choice. This program is intended as a helping hand for families enrolling their children at a private school for the <u>first time</u>.
