



Parent-Student Handbook Addendums

Absences and School Activities

The following policy change is effective immediately.

A student must attend four consecutive class periods during the day an activity is taking place if he or she wishes to participate. This policy applies to all absences, including those medically excused. Funerals or mandated court appearances are exceptions to this policy. (See page 43, electronic version at SPSV.org.)

Excessive Absence and Loss of Credit

The following policy change will be effective January 7, 2019 for the second semester of the 2018-2019 school year.

Students who are absent from a particular class (whether excused or unexcused) more than 20% of the class meetings may receive no credit for the semester and will need to remediate this course according to the policies stated in this handbook. The determination to allow credit or not is made by the administration in consultation with the student, parents, counselor, and students' teachers. Students with extended illnesses or disabilities may be asked to withdraw from St. Patrick-St. Vincent Catholic High School, and invited to re-apply after the student returns to good standing.
