General Description

Qualifications

Professional:

- A Bachelor's Degree is preferred for this position, preferably related to the field of education.
- Minimum of one (1) to three (3) years of experience working with children is preferred.

Personal:

- The employee is a Christian with an authentic and mature personal relationship with Jesus Christ in both their professional and personal life with a calling and commitment to Christian education.
- Evidence of a lifestyle that reflects a dynamic relationship with Christ.
- Is open-minded, tolerant, and happy in his/her outlook on life.
- Makes a good appearance Dress and styles are appropriate.
- Is sensitive to the needs of others, cares about the feelings of others, shows Christian concern for all, maintains confidences, and is respectful of others.
- Uses correct language in spoken and written form, and is an effective listener.
- Is tactful and courteous.
- Is punctual.
