I am excited to announce that I will be your child's second grade teacher. Here are a few suggestions for maintaining the skills your child has learned this year in first grade.

*Math: Have your child practice their basic math facts. When entering second grade, it would be helpful if your child knew these basic facts. Using flash cards is a great way to ensure your child knows his/her basic math facts. Also, go online and visit websites such as AdaptedMind (www.adaptedmind.com) and IXL Learning (www.ixl.com) for a fun twist on basic math practice. Complete the required math lessons on IXL listed in this packet.

*Handwriting: Have your child practice their very best handwriting. It must be neat and legible! We will begin learning cursive letters in January and if his/her handwriting is messy it will make the transition to cursive more difficult. One way you can encourage good penmanship is to have your child keep a summer journal. Encourage them to write about their summer adventures and draw pictures to go with their stories, while guiding them on the way they form their letters.

*Reading: Read Frog and Toad Are Friends by Arnold Lobel to or with your child and have them complete the attached worksheets. These worksheets are due on the first day of school. In addition, encourage other reading this summer. Allow your child to choose some of their own summer reading material and ask them questions about the books they read.

Don't forget to order school supplies from 1^{st} Day School Supplies (link on school's website) by July 1. They will be delivered directly to my classroom with your child's name.

Have a nice, relaxing, and enjoyable summer. I look forward to seeing you in August!



Required IXL: Complete the required math lessons on IXL listed in this packet.


Religion: In second grade your child will be tested on prayers said during Mass. Attending Mass weekly will help them remember the prayers.
