Development of Strategic Plan

During the 2016-2017 school year, the Principal and School Board members began working to develop its next five-year Strategic Plan in order to facilitate a plan for continued success at Sacred Heart School. Other stakeholders, including faculty, staff, and parents, added valuable input through retreats, group sessions, and surveys. A list of objectives was created based on our belief to educate the "whole child"-mind, body, and soul. Our fundamental purpose is to teach an "above standard" curriculum with teachings rooted in the Catholic faith and Gospel truths. Individual committees were formed within the Board and goals for each objective were formulated. The final draft of the Strategic Plan was approved in 2017. The involvement of all stakeholders was key to the success of this plan.

- 1. To ensure that prayer and worship services are a regular part of the the daily school life.

Academic Excellence Goal Two

SACRED HEART SCHOOL WILL CONTINUE TO PROVIDE A RIGOROUS AND HIGHLY ACADEMIC PROGRAM PROMOTING ATTENTION TO THE INDIVIDUAL NEEDS OF THE STUDENTS THROUGH DIFFERENTIATED LEARNING.

- 1. To strengthen the Middle School program in the areas of English Language Arts, Math, and Technology so students are better prepared for high school.
- 2. To develop different teaching strategies to address the learning needs of individual students.
- 3. To expand resource programs, including English Language Arts, Math, Speech, and Emotional Health.
- 4. To utilize testing data and research based strategies to drive instruction in the classrooms.





Governance and Leadership Goal Three

THE SACRED HEART SCHOOL BOARD AND PRINCIPAL WILL WORK TOGETHER IN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT TO ENSURE THE FUTURE VIABILITY OF THE SCHOOL.

- 1. To continue to educate the Board on their roles as promoters of the school's mission.
- 2. To clarify the roles and responsibilities of each Board member in reference to the committees they are involved with.
- 3. To develop a plan to select future Board members with the priorities aligned in the Strategic Plan.
- 4. To develop a Board training program for new and returning Board members, utilizing the Catholic Schools Management program.





Facilities Goal Four

SACRED HEART SCHOOL WILL ENSURE A SAFE ENVIRONMENT FOR THE SCHOOL COMMUNITY.

- 1. To form a committee of school and Parish stakeholders with knowledge of safety and security to evaluate facilities and form a safety plan.
- 2. To create standard procedures to assure safety in the school classrooms and playground.
- 3. To identify and take actions to correct areas of security vulnerability.
- 4. To develop a limited access system with the use of identity badges and educate the school community on security protocols.
- 5. To upgrade the communication system within the school.






Technology Goal Five

SACRED HEART SCHOOL WILL ANNUALLY REVIEW AND UPDATE THE SCHOOL TECHNOLOGY NEEDS.

- 1. To secure funding to support the school's ongoing technology efforts.
- 2. To upgrade the existing network infrastructure and school technology devices to support all student and administration environments.
- 3. To provide staff with current technology tools and the training necessary to understand and utilize them.
- 4. To increase one-to-one devices in the upper grades, particularly the Middle School.





Enrollment Goal Six

SACRED HEART SCHOOL WILL ATTRACT AND RETAIN A
DIVERSE STUDENT POPULATION AT AN OPTIMUM
ENROLLMENT OF 350 IN GRADES PRESCHOOL THROUGH
EIGHTH GRADE.

- 1. To continue recruitment strategies including school open houses, tours, information nights, media coverage, and on-going information to neighboring parishes.
- 2. To develop a Family Ambassador Program for new incoming families.
- 3. To annually evaluate the admission and recruitment process.





Development Goal Seven

SACRED HEART SCHOOL WILL CONTINUE TO DEVELOP A SUSTAINED MARKETING PROGRAM TO INCREASE AWARENESS ABOUT THE SCHOOL AND CATHOLIC EDUCATION TO THE PARISH AND COMMUNITY.

- 1. To improve communication with alumni, parents, friends, and donors through "The Saint's Word," promotional materials, and the school website.
- 2. To maintain and regularly update the school website.
- 3. To develop an alumni database.
- 4. To seek out other sources for school needs and the Tuition Assistance Program.
- 5. To enhance visibility of Sacred Heart School in the local community.





Financial Sustainability Goal Eight

SACRED HEART SCHOOL WILL MAINTAIN A BALANCED BUDGET THAT WILL PROVIDE FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR THE SCHOOL'S SHORT AND LONG TERM OPERATIONS.

- 1. To control tuition increases, while continuing to provide a high quality and rigorous academic education.
- 2. To ensure the school continues to have a sustainable savings and "rainy day account."
- 3. To continue overseeing the budget by the school finance council.
- 4. To provide faculty salaries that are increased by steps each year.
