

**COMMUNITY RELATIONS**

**BP 1250    Visitors/Guests**

The Board encourages visits to the schools and programs operated by the Superintendent by parent/guardians, members of the community, and other interested persons in order to view the education program and facilities and to offer constructive comments.

Parents, community members, and other interested persons may attend school programs such as open house occasions, special program events, and observe classroom activities.

Classroom visits by members of the community and other interested persons shall be approved in advance by the administrator or administrator designee in charge. Approval or denial will be based upon whether there is a reasonable basis to conclude that the visit will interfere with school activities. In all cases, responsible and appropriate behavior shall be required of all visitors.

Visitors who pose a threat to the health and safety of students, teachers, or other personnel or who otherwise disrupt the normal operations of the school shall be removed.

Possession of unauthorized dangerous instruments, weapons, or devices is prohibited on school premises or any other place where a teacher or a student are required to be in connection with assigned school activities.

This Board policy is subordinate to applicable policies and procedures of school districts, community colleges, training institutions, Probation Department, or other agencies having legal jurisdiction over the student.
