BP 2010 Concepts and Roles in Administration

The County Board and the County Superintendent are constitutional officers which have duties and responsibilities specified in various codes and regulations. The general duties and powers of the County Board and the County Superintendent are set forth in the Education Code.

Mandatory duties of the County Board are enumerated in Education Code section 1040. Mandatory duties of the County Superintendent are set forth in Education Code section 1240. Both the County Superintendent and the County Board have discretion to act, under Education Code sections 35160, et seq., provided that such action is not in conflict with, or preempted by, any law.

Superintendent is the employer of all County Office employees.
