**BP 2130 Functions of the County Superintendent/Duties of the
County Superintendent of Schools**

Keep the Board and public informed on the status of the educational program under the Superintendent’s jurisdiction, and make such recommendations for changes and improvements that will promote the welfare of the county schools program.

Inform the Board on educational developments that have a bearing on the duties or policies of the Board.

Employ a professional staff to assist in carrying out Board and Superintendent policies.

Offer professional leadership through perpetual improvement to staff and programs.

Develop and administer the regulations and procedures governing employer-employee relations under state and federal statutes.

Enter into contracts as necessary to perform the duties required by the Education Code.

Comply with all the duties and responsibilities set forth by state law.
