Concepts and Roles in Business and Non-Instructional Operations

Real Property

It is the responsibility of the Superintendent and Board to provide students and staff a suitable, safe and healthful environment. Therefore, it is the policy of the Superintendent that adequate and appropriate real property be provided to meet the housing needs for the programs and services of the County Office of Education.

The Superintendent assigns responsibility to the Unit Supervisor for Administrative Services to develop and implement procedures that will comply with all laws, codes and regulations. Lease purchases, purchases, or sale agreements shall be subjected to Superintendent's approval. Real property purchases are subject to Board approval.

Title to real property is held in the name of the County Superintendent and is referred to as the El Dorado County Office of Education.
