

BUSINESS AND NON-INSTRUCTIONAL OPERATIONS

Food Service

Other Food Sales

The Superintendent shall permit food sales by student or adult entities or organizations provided that these sales are in compliance with state and federal regulations so as to ensure optimum student participation in the school food service program. Such food sales shall not impair the food service's ability to be financially sound.

Sanitation and safety procedures shall comply with the requirements of the California Uniform Retail Food Facilities Law as set forth in Health and Safety Code 27500 et seq.

Schools that participate in the National School Lunch Program and/or School Breakfast Program shall allow no foods of minimal nutritional value to be sold in food service areas during breakfast and lunch periods. At elementary schools, food other than that offered by the school food services may be sold only four times a year and only after the close of the last lunch period.

The Superintendent believes that all food available for students at school should contribute to the development of sound nutritional habits. All foods offered by student or adult entities or groups should reflect concern for the health and well-being of our students.
