

CERTIFICATED PERSONNEL

Retirement

Employees should notify the Superintendent of their intention to retire as soon as possible so that a suitable replacement may be found. Notice must be given by April 1 preceding the intended contract year of retirement. If requested, the Superintendent may extend the April 1 deadline.

Resignations

Employee resignations shall be effective when accepted by the Superintendent or designee.

Formal rejection or refusal to sign the employer's Offer of Employment by the date required thereon may be considered as a resignation.
