Code of Ethics

Employees shall provide services with integrity and high ideals. Employees are expected to maintain high standards in their working relationships. These standards included the following:

- maintaining courteous professional relationships with districts, students, fellow staff, and the public;
- maintaining efficiency and knowledge of the developments in assigned areas of responsibility;
- conducting all County Office of Education related professional activities properly and within established protocol;
- establishing and maintaining cooperative working relationships with districts, other agencies and the community;
- placing the welfare of the students as first concern of the County Office of Education;
- restraining from using County Office of Education, school contacts and privileges to promote partisan politics, sectarian religious views or propaganda of any kind;
- protecting and properly using County Office of Education properties, equipment and materials.

Employees shall adhere to the Rules of Conduct as outlined in the Code of Regulations, Title V, Sections 80331-80338.
