STUDENTS

Concept and Roles in Student Personnel

Students are expected to accept <u>personal responsibility</u> for making maximum use of those educational opportunities afforded by applying themselves diligently to the enterprise of learning both in the classroom and in other school-sponsored settings. It is also expected that as a result of the total school experience students will come to appreciate the values of self-discipline, responsibility, respect for others, civility, their country and its governmental processes.
