

STUDENTS**Welfare-Health Standards**

The County Office of Education recognizes the importance of student health. It is the intent of the County Office of Education to maintain the highest level of health standards in those programs operated by the County Office of Education. The County Office of Education directs that no student shall be denied the right to an education due to special health care requirements and that students are entitled to an education in the least restrictive environment.

The County Office of Education encourages employees to work cooperatively with local health agencies and officers to take the necessary measures for the prevention and control of communicable diseases, in accordance with Board policy.
