In order to designate District representatives authorized to certify required forms relative to the State School Facility Program, the Superintendent recommends the Board adopt Resolution 2017-10 - Supporting the Application for Eligibility Determination and Funding for the State School Facility Program (SAB 50-03 and 50-04 Forms).*

10.2 First Reading of Revised Board Policies

Due to column movement based on attainment of additional educational units and step movement, Janet Bath, Special Services teacher, will receive a salary adjustment of \$10,480, effective August 1, 2017.
