May: "Are We There Yet?" Almost to the Yellow Tier...

Christ Is Risen! He Is Risen Indeed!

Just when I was starting to get hopeful about new freedoms in the Yellow tier, I received (4/30) three lists of requirements and mandates for the Orange Tier. So – even though we're very likely just a few days from entering the yellow tier, we are going to double down on the Orange Tier rules.



Not that I'm frustrated or anything – ok, yes, I'm frustrated... trying to help the school through the various requirements, trying to get ready for an in-person, indoor graduation service on June 17th, and all the rest that goes along with normal life here... it's been a tiring week. Aren't we almost through with all of this? Surely we're almost there, right?

A LOT of life is like this, isn't it? We have so many "almost, not yet" moments, and have to endure times that are draining and exhausting. How do we make it through these times?

Our Gospel lesson for this Sunday points us in a great direction. In John 15:5, Jesus says, "I am the vine, you are the branches. Those who abide in me and I in them bear much fruit, because apart from me you can do nothing." What does this have to do with frustrations and stresses? Quite a bit, I think.

If the branch (that's you!) of a grape vine is grafted onto a grape vine (that's Jesus!), things will go as expected. The branch will bear fruit as one would expect. If, however, a branch is disconnected from the grape vine, OR is grafted onto something or someone else, either no fruit or diseased fruit is produced.

What does this have to do with us? If we don't "abide" in Jesus, if we're disconnected from Jesus – completely or even mostly – we won't bear any fruit. We'll wither and die. If we are grafted onto something or someone else, and try to gain strength and nourishment from that, we won't produce the expected fruit. Any difficulties, big or even pretty small, will overwhelm us, possibly even destroy us.

Think about the fruit that you're producing in life – and compare it to what you COULD be producing as someone abiding in Jesus. In Galatians 5:22-23 we find the list: Love, Joy, Peace, Patience, Kindness, Goodness, Faithfulness, Gentleness and Self -Control. If these aren't being produced in you, something's not right.

Now that isn't to say that there won't be times that we're tested – of course we will! But as we encounter these moments (or years!) of testing, we endure because we abide in Jesus – even if we're in the Orange Tier a little longer.

Mother's Day!

May 9th is the day we take time to remember, not just our Mothers, but also those women who have played special roles in our lives, and to give thanks to God for his work in us through them. It is also a day to acknowledge difficulties in some of those relationships, as well as loss for those of us mourning a passing of that significant person.

One of the things I enjoy is seeing mothers and grandmothers who have guilted, um, I mean, *invited* their children and grandchildren (or great grandchildren!) to join them in worship on that day. It's always fun to see families come together, especially as we come out from under COVID restrictions! We're planning some special things that day, and we'd love you and your family to attend.



It has been so wonderful to see people in church again! Please be safe and careful, but if you're able, it would be so good to see you. We're socially distanced, hand-sanitized, masked, temperature and health-checked, and so happy to see you!
