"WHAT ARE YOU LOOKING FOR?"

I love this question that Jesus posed to his newly minted disciples, Andrew and Simon Peter, in this Sunday's gospel lesson (John 1:29-42). They had heard John the Baptist say that Jesus was "the Lamb of God (we'll talk about that term on Sunday) who takes away the sin of the world" and that he would "baptize with the Holy Spirit." From this they deduced that Jesus was the Messiah, the one for whom the Jews had been waiting for over a thousand years.

Imagine finding yourself at that amazing crossroad of history and divine intervention in the world! It would be overwhelming, to say the least!

This context gives Jesus' question even more importance: "What ARE you looking for?" If you're looking for the fulfillment of GOD'S promises and the chance to be a part of what God is doing for the salvation of the world, you've come to the right place. If you're looking for wealth, riches, fame, power, and so on... you're going to be disappointed because this isn't about you.

Jesus' question is for us as well: "What are you looking for?" How we answer that question determines what happens next for us. And it still isn't about us.

The season of Epiphany, which comes right after Christmas and before Lent, helps us consider the "why" of Jesus' coming, as well as how it impacts us and our lives. Epiphany IS the answer to Jesus' question to the disciples. Our Epiphany journey helps line everything up correctly and points us toward the cross and resurrection.

What Do We Teach the Children during "Chapel Time"?

Our preschool children have a short chapel time daily with their teachers. On Thursdays and Fridays, Pastor Larry leads chapel for us with his guitar—which the children LOVE! Each week, we focus on a different Bible story during our chapel times. In the first half of our school year, we focus on the Old Testament, including the creation story, Moses, Abraham, Joseph, etc. December was devoted to the Christmas story, and now in January, we move on into Jesus' life. Because we want our families to be a part of their child's faith learning, we include a monthly list of our Bible stories in our weekly newsletters, and add the page number of the story in the Spark Story Bible, so they can follow along at home. Below is the Family Faith page for January.

Week I

The Boy at the Temple Jesus' family went on a trip every year to the Temple in Jerusalem. The family walked there with many other people. On one of these trips, when Jesus was 12 years old, Mary and Joseph couldn't find Jesus. They were afraid he was lost! They finally found him—he was in the Temple telling people about God.

Week 2

— John the Baptist John the Baptist was Jesus 'cousin. God gave him an important job: to tell people that Jesus was coming! John stood by a river, teaching, preaching, and baptizing people. "Jesus is coming! He will save us all!" John shouted. Some people didn't listen. But many people believed John and were ready for Jesus.

God, thank you for all the people who tell us about Jesus. Amen.

Week 3

— Jesus the Word and His Baptism John baptized people who wanted to change their lives and follow God. He also said someone was coming who would change the world. One day his cousin Jesus asked to be baptized. When Jesus came up out of the water, the Holy Spirit appeared in the form of a dove, and a voice said, "This is my Son. He is beloved and chosen!"


