POLICY REGARDING SUPERVISION OF RELATIVES

The following regulations shall govern conflicts of interest in the supervision of staff:

- 1. No family member of an administrator shall be assigned to work in a position where he/she reports directly to the administrator to whom he/she is related, unless approved in writing by the Superintendent or his/her designee.
- 2. No family member of the Superintendent shall be assigned to work in a position where he/she reports directly to the Superintendent, unless approved in writing by the Board of Education.

For the purposes of this section, "family member" shall be defined as spouse, child, parent, sister, brother, sister-in-law, brother-in-law, mother-in-law, father-in-law, daughter-in-law, son-in-law, aunt, uncle, niece, nephew, grandparent or grandchild.

It is the intent of these rules to avoid any situation where a conflict of interest can arise on the part of the member of the administrative staff of the Sprague Board of Education.
