POLICY REGARDING HONOR SOCIETY / HONOR ROLL

**Establishment**

The establishment of an honor society shall be optional at the middle school level, and subject to the approval of the building administrator. The handbooks of the National Junior Honor Society and the National Honor Society are used as general procedural guides in established chapters of these national organizations.

**Eligibility**

Seventh and eighth grade students are eligible for membership at the middle school or junior high level.

**Selection of Honor Society Members**

Students will be selected for the honor society in accordance with National Junior Honor Society requirements.

**Selection of Honor Roll Members**

1. For high honors, students must have no grade lower than an A- in all academic classes. Physical education, art, music, world language, and computer will be combined for an average grade not lower than a B.
2. For honors, students must have no grade lower than a B- in all academic classes. Physical education, art, music, world language, and computer will be combined for an average grade not lower than a B-.
