Why Choose CTE Pathways?

- About 53% of employment requires middle-skills - According to the National Skills Coalition. This means that more than half of jobs in America require more than a high school diploma but less than a 4-year degree.
- Allows students to see if this career is a good fit prior to declaring a college major.
- CTE courses prepare students for higher paying jobs after high school
- CTE courses provide both technical and academic skills

Option 1: Excel Teacher-Led Virtual Course Pathways (requires 4 sem/2 years)

Excel Academy CTE Pathways

Career and Technical Education (CTE) are a series of high school elective courses that provide students with opportunities to explore career pathways and experience hands-on training and education in career fields that interest them.

Students may choose a career pathway which consists of two years/four semesters. Year one is called a concentrator, and year two is called a completer. They will move through each semester with a cohort of students. Courses are taught by a CA credentialed CTE teacher.

When a student completes all of the courses in a specific Excel CTE pathway, they will earn a CTE Completers Certificate along with an opportunity to earn certifications in their career field.
