2020-21 School Year School begins Monday, August 17th. The Catholic School Department has asked that all schools provide a three-week orientation opportunity in which small cohorts of students (no more than 10 per classroom) are able to prepare for distance learning.

- This small cohort time between 9:00-11:00am on one assigned day/date per week will give our teachers the best chance of connecting with their students.
- Students will receive their textbooks and supply packs (if ordered)
- Teachers will distribute the student’s Chromebook (Gr. 2-8 only)
- Teachers will instruct in Zoom or Google Meet
- Teachers will instruct on how to access the different apps students will use.
- Teachers will give the students the STAR assessments.
- Teachers will provide parents with up-to-date STAR results during our Parent/Student/Teacher Conference (Week 3).
- Teachers will train students on the Return-to-School Protocol, what happens during school-time when we are back together, temperature taking upon arrival, mask wearing, handwashing, sanitizing,

Whether your family has requested consideration for At-Home Learning or will be joining St. Rose School for In-person Learning, all students are expected to attend these small cohort orientations. We have taken every precaution following the assigned protocols to keep teachers and students safe, physically distanced, and masked or face-shielded.

Please see the family list on pages 8-9 which indicates which day your child/ren will be on campus from 9am-11am for the first three weeks of school.

Uniform Policy During the 3-week orientation from August 17-September 4 students may wear their school uniform (shorts/skorts/polo shirt) or comfortable summer clothing appropriate for school.

Medication Forms New forms are available in the school office or on SchoolSpeak<School Forms<[Administration Of Medicine During School Hours By School Personnel](#). A reminder that ALL medications, this includes over the counter medicines, must have a current school release form on file for it to be administered by school personnel. Students are prohibited from having any medications on their person or from bringing them into the classroom with them. Medications must be kept in the school office. A new form MUST be completed by a physician and parent each school year.

All School Loop Please enter and exit school from August 17-September 4 through the loop. Please see the diagram on page 10 with instructions on how students/parents will walk into school.

Arrival Loop: Large Loop Gate opens 8:35am; form one line around outside of Loop for drop-off of children.

- Cars circle Loop; drop students off at the curb behind the church
- Parents wishing to walk their children to class must park cars in the center of the parking area and cross carefully to meet children.
- Parents depart via large gate & return at 11:00am for dismissal

Dismissal Loop: Large Loop Gate opens 10:45; form two lanes around the outside of Loop.

- Drivers take turns merging to form a pick-up line along the curb.
- Drivers pull all the way up to the priests' garage (6-7 cars fit along the curb)
- Children will be watching for their cars and be ready to enter their car when drivers come to a stop along the curb.

Required Health Records Students MUST be in compliance with the following immunizations requirements in order to start school on Monday, August 17, 2020. Incoming Kindergarten

- Proof of immunizations - must be current with POLIO, DTP, MMR, HEPATITIS B series. Also required is either the VARICELLA immunization or date the child had chickenpox.

Incoming First Grade

- Proof of a physical exam done within 18 months of the start of first grade.

Incoming Seventh Grade

- Proof of Tdap booster shot on or after their 10th birthday.

Summer Homework (gr. 5-8) Don't forget, all summer reading homework is due on your first day of school or as designated by your Reading/Literature teacher. Please refer to your class SchoolSpeak page if you have any questions about your assignments.
