They offend Thee, my God, who art all-good and  
Deserving of all my love. I firmly resolve, with the  
Help of Thy grace, to confess my sins, to do penance,  
And to amend my life.    Amen.

#### **Apostles' Creed**

Died, and was buried.

and where there is sadness, joy.

Grant that I may not so much seek to be consoled as to console;

That we are born to eternal life.

whom I have injured. Amen.

## **Fifth Grade – add the following prayer**

### **Hail Holy Queen**

Hail, Holy Queen, Mother of Mercy, our life, our sweetness and our hope. To you we cry, poor banished children of Eve. To you do we send up our sighs, mourning and weeping in this valley of tears. Turn then, most gracious Advocate, your eyes of mercy toward us. And after this our exile show unto us the blessed fruit of your womb, Jesus. O clement, O loving, O sweet Virgin Mary, Pray for us, Holy Mother of God, That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

## **Sixth Grade – add the following prayers**

### **Memorare**

Remember, O most gracious Virgin Mary, that never was it known that anyone who fled to your protection, implored your help, or sought your intercession, was left unaided. Inspired by this confidence, I fly to you, O Virgin of Virgins, my Mother. To you I come; before you I stand, sinful and sorrowful. O Mother of the Word Incarnate, despise not my petitions, but in your mercy, hear and answer me. Amen.

## **Seventh Grade – add the following prayer**

### **Nicene Creed**

We believe in one holy, catholic and apostolic Church. We acknowledge one baptism for the forgiveness of sins. We look for the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come. Amen.
