MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT



Dear Friends of Cristo Rey Sacramento,

Resilience. Cristo Rey High School Sacramento fits perfectly into the definition of resilience: The ability to adapt well in the face of adversity; the ability to recover quickly from difficulties.

On Monday, March 16th Cristo Rey students were asked to pick up materials from the school and return home for what we thought would be two weeks of distance learning. On August 10th, we began our new school year, still in distance learning. However, our collective resilience shone through. Distance learning today has significantly improved from our first attempt in March. Thanks to a generous anonymous donation of \$200,000 all of our students have access to brand new chromebooks. In addition, our faculty and staff have been able to access necessary resources making distance learning as effective as possible. I am pleased to report that our academic community is working hard to continue to deliver on the promise of a Catholic, college preparatory education for our students. Our focus on our mission is relentless.

In the Spring, our donor community and our Work Study sponsors responded with great generosity. In spite of the cancellation of our annual Scholarship Dinner: *Rey of Hope*, our supporters still "showed up" in a big way and helped to generate much needed funds for the *Sister Eileen Enright, RSM fund*. Additionally, all of our 2019-2020 Work Study Sponsors honored their commitment even though we were not able to send students to work. As we entered the summer, we weren't sure how many of our Work Study partners would be able to return, and through another act of great generosity, they did. While we do not have the same number of paid work positions as we did pre-COVID, we are grateful to the many Work Study sponsors who did renew. The continued support for our shared mission is inspiring, and is in large part the reason Cristo Rey Sacramento has been so resilient since our start in 2006.

While we are not certain how much longer we will be in distance learning, we remain committed to doing everything we can to maintain a healthy environment for our students, and for our community. What we do know is that Cristo Rey has been tested before, and we emerged stronger. We know that this moment in our history is another test, and our resilience will shine through as we emerge from this pandemic. We have this confidence because of the efforts and the commitment to our mission as expressed by our entire community: our students and families, our faculty and staff, our work study sponsors, the Sisters of Mercy and the Jesuits, and to you, our loyal supporters.

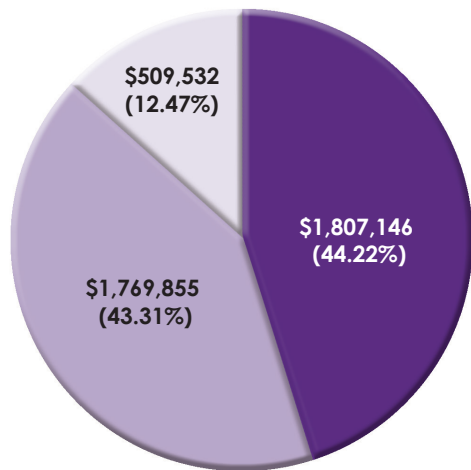

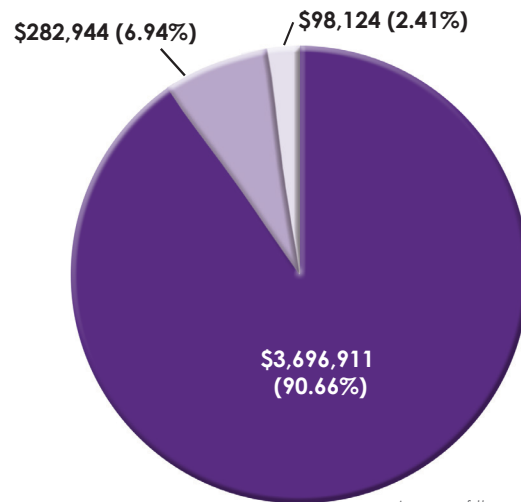

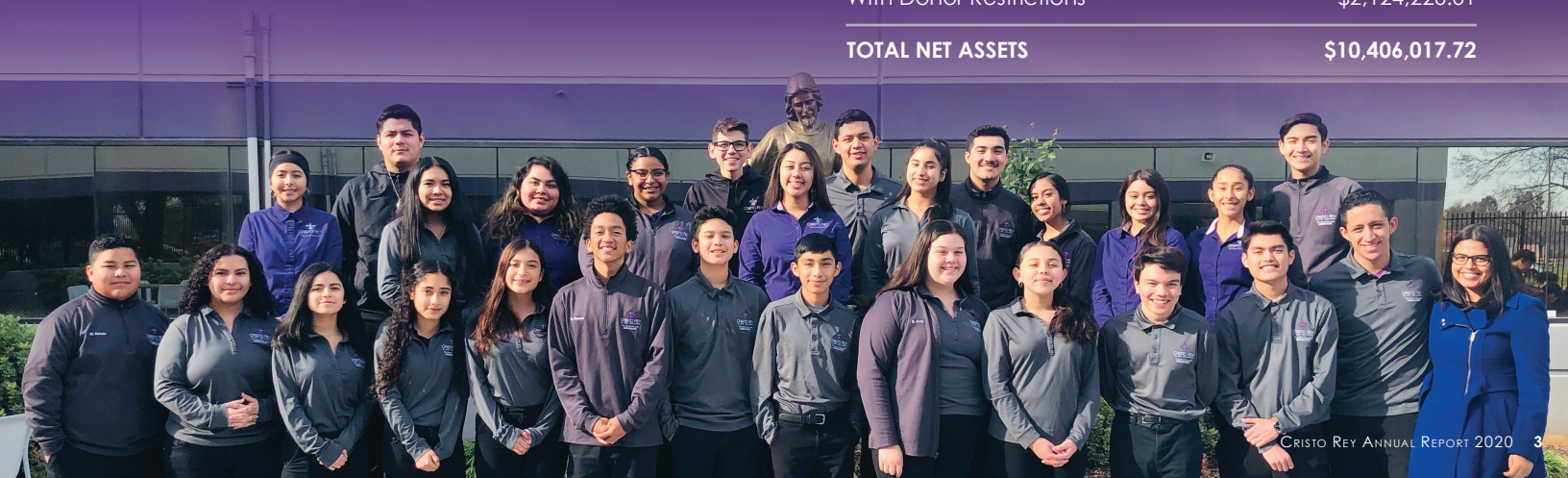

PRINCIPAL SPOTLIGHT: MS. KATE COULOURAS



Kate Coulouras began teaching in summer of 2004. She has taught Spanish, Social Studies, English, Art and Athletics to middle school and high school aged students. Her teachings have spanned the United States and Mexico, from New Orleans, Chicago, Isla Mujeres, Cancun and Sacramento. Ms. Coulouras was the Spanish Department Chair at Cristo Rey Sacramento since 2014 and launched the AP Spanish Language and Culture course in 2016. Ms. Coulouras received her Bachelor's degree in Spanish from Saint Mary's College of California in 2009 and her Master's degree in Educational Leadership from University of Notre Dame in 2019.

Ms. Coulouras' top priority as a principal is to "ensure that all students are provided with a highly effective and rigorous education that prepares them for college and beyond. Our students come to us from such diverse backgrounds and have unique academic and emotional needs. I believe that effective teaching and learning starts with excellent teachers that prioritize the care for the whole child."

Ms. Coulouras further notes, "I feel confident that my experiences as a teacher and leader on campus, my commitment to the Catholic Church, and the positive relationships I have created with the faculty, students and families have prepared me to take on the responsibilities of Principal. I am excited and look forward to engaging our faculty in growing our mission of providing a college-preparatory education to our students while guiding and supporting them to become men and women for others."

DEAN OF STUDENTS SPOTLIGHT: FR. CHRISTOPHER CALDERÓN, S.J.



Fr. Calderón was born in South Los Angeles, CA, into a large and loving family of Mexican heritage. His grandmother taught him how to pray. His mother modeled for him the importance of humble and generous sacrifice. And his whole family instilled in him the importance of loving bonds. With these things as his life's foundation and Catholic education as his roadmap, he would attend the University of San Francisco, majoring in Latin American Studies, as well as serving as the community service coordinator for university's campus ministry office. After graduation, he heeded the Holy Spirit's invitation to join the Society of Jesus—the Jesuits—in 2006. He was ordained a Catholic priest in 2017.

With the Jesuits, he would study at Loyola University Chicago, Boston College, and the Graduate School of Education at Harvard University. And he would serve in a variety of ministries, including several Jesuit schools, various L'Arche communities, state penitentiaries, parishes, and more. Most recently, he has served as a faculty member and as the Director of Community Outreach at Jesuit High School, Portland, Oregon.

"Days before the semester took hold, I wondered how I, as a new Dean of Students, would connect with those I am meant to serve when our campus is quiet and their return date inexact. With several months under my belt, the campus remains quiet, but the connections—moments of laughter and prayer, of refocusing and careful guidance—are taking place in simple, sacred, and abundant ways. Often a Dean is seen as the person who is charged with discipline; however, when I interviewed for this position, I was moved to hear that at Cristo Rey Sacramento the Dean's charge is help form our students, helping them realize who they are called to be and helping them stay on a path that is good and life giving. As an educator and as a Jesuit Priest, I was hooked. Over the last several weeks, not only have I seen how true these things are but I have witnessed how committed everyone is to making it so. And while our circumstances are unusual, I am grateful to God that I am part of a place where I get to witness the Holy Spirit hard at work. I am grateful to this community for the warm welcome that makes all that is new exciting. And while I cannot be sure how the year will unfold, I hope that we can all continue to be formed by one another, as we care for one another."

ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL SPOTLIGHT: MRS. JENNA TRYON POLHEMUS



Jenna began her teaching career at Sacramento Charter High School in 2013 and then joined the Cristo Rey Sacramento community in 2015. Jenna has filled many roles at Cristo Rey High School, preparing her to join the school leadership team as Assistant Principal. Jenna currently teaches 10th grade Biology but has also taught 12th grade Anatomy and Physiology. Last year, in addition to her teaching responsibilities, she generously took on the role of Director of Academic Support for Cristo Rey where she coordinated our tutoring program, mentored new teachers and managed students' academic success. Jenna continues in her role as the on-campus support provider for the Induction Credentialing Program through Sacramento City Unified School District.

Jenna received a double major undergraduate degree from Bucknell University in Religion and Biology. She then went on to earn her Master's degree in Urban Education from Loyola Marymount University and is currently pursuing her doctorate in Educational Leadership from Sacramento State University.

Jenna states, "Cristo Rey has been such an integral part of my professional development and growth over the last five years. I am excited to be able to take on a new position at Cristo Rey Sacramento and have an increased responsibility towards achieving our mission and vision."

SAINT SPOTLIGHT: ESMERALDA ROSAS



Esmeralda Rosas, a member of the Class of 2021, is just one shining example of the Saints here at Cristo Rey High School Sacramento. Esme is a transfer student; she chose to attend Cristo Rey after completing her Freshman year at a charter school in the Sacramento Area. When asked why she chose Cristo Rey, Esme replied, "I was looking for a close-knit school community, a school that would provide opportunities and resources for low-income students and most importantly a school that would help me expand my relationship with God. Fortunately that's exactly what I found at Cristo Rey."

Esme has been employed at L&D Landfill and Yolo Adult Day Health Center and she credits both experiences as helping her to grow in confidence, leadership skills, and preparation for life in college and in the workforce. In addition to Esmeralda's work study experience, she has been busy in the classroom and in the school community participating in things such as: Yearbook Club, the President's Circle, the Ambassadors, Student Ministry, Social Justice Club, Co-led a Support Group on campus and has created educational/inspirational videos for the school to watch. Esmeralda's commitment to being a young adult for others is highlighted by a compliment from her supervisors at L&D Landfill: "We

had a great experience working with Esme Rosas as one of our participants in the Cristo Rey Work Study program. It was a pleasure having her smiling face around the office. Esme has excellent people skills, an enthusiasm for learning and compassion for her fellow human beings. One of the challenges we face in our business is with the homeless population. Esme took an interest in the homeless and in the efforts of the Sacramento community to address the issue. She pursued this interest with Sister Libby Fernandez and her Mercy Pedalers program, recording a video of her experience and interaction with the homeless. It was a joy to find a young person with such drive; our entire staff was inspired by her efforts. She is a remarkable young lady."

Esmeralda is preparing for college applications at this time, and planning on what life will look like when she graduates from college. Esme will apply to many colleges and universities, including Notre Dame, Loyola Marymount, Santa Clara, UCLA, UC Merced and Sacramento State to name a few. Esme is planning to study Psychology to pursue a dream she has had since the 8th grade to be a Counseling or Clinical Psychologist. Her ultimate goal is to pursue a Doctorate in this field...there is no doubt she has the capacity, and will be successful in this pursuit.

As Esme shared recently, "I look forward to graduating and living a successful life because I will be able to take with me the values, skills, and positive attitude, taught to me by Cristo Rey. I hope for a future where more Cristo Rey students will be able to enjoy a similar experience at Cristo Rey High School. This would not be possible without the support of all you amazing donors."

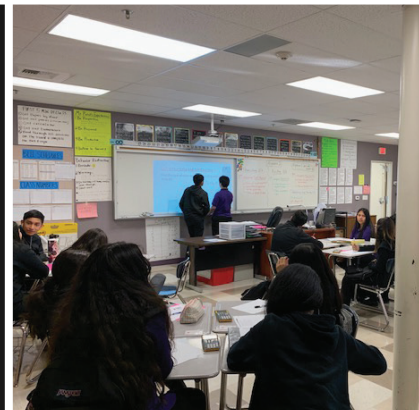
