

MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT



Dear Friends of Cristo Rey Sacramento,

Welcome to *The School that Works*. Cristo Rey High School Sacramento, part of the Cristo Rey Network exists to provide a private, Catholic, college preparatory high school education to students with limited financial resources. Opening our doors to the Sacramento community in 2006, we are proud of our alumni and the many accomplishments they have achieved to date, and we are excited about the future. Our mission and vision are guided by the deep traditions of Catholic education excellence from our Co-Sponsors, the Sisters of Mercy of the Americas and the Society of Jesus (Jesuits).

Our students enjoy a robust, challenging education and participate in co-curricular activities and gain real work experience as they work five days a month through our Work Study Program. We are grateful to our many generous donors, Work Study sponsors, the faculty, staff and community members who believe in the mission of Cristo Rey High School Sacramento.

As a part of a larger network, 37 Cristo Rey schools in 2019-2020, we are able to track student performance and outcomes related to academic and personal success. Across the network, Cristo Rey students are persisting to a Bachelor's Degree at a rate of three times their peers who did not have a Cristo Rey experience. Last year, we had students accepted and enrolled in Stanford University, UC Davis, UC Los Angeles, UC Santa Barbara, UC Berkeley, Holy Names University, Sacramento State University and many more. We know that this is a result of the attention we place on attending to the needs of the whole person, what the Jesuits refer to as *Cura Personalis*. *Cura Personalis* calls educators to care for and see the needs of the whole student, mind, body and spirit. In a similar way, Blessed Catherine McAuley encouraged her community to care for each other and for those they were called to serve, and used a cup of tea as a symbol of hospitality, comfort, and health. We are honored to have been called to serve the students entrusted to our care by the wonderful parents of Cristo Rey.

The best way to know and understand how the Cristo Rey model is breaking the cycle of poverty is to witness it in action. I invite you to be my guest on a tour of our inspiring school. When you have the chance to meet our students, our faculty and staff, you will understand why Cristo Rey is *The School that Works*.



Sister Eileen Enright, RSM, former President of Cristo Rey fondly notes, "When I first met Bob and Marilyn, I was inspired by their love of life, hearts full of hope, humble down-to-earth commitment to the community and generosity." Bob and Marilyn saw the importance and need for a Cristo Rey School in Sacramento from the beginning and have been faithful and humble benefactors ever since. 



RELIGIOUS SPONSORSHIP COLLABORATION



Religious Sponsorship refers to the unique relationship of oversight, endorsement and support by a group that commits to advancing the teaching ministry of Jesus. A religious community, such as the Society of Jesus (Jesuits) or the Sisters of Mercy, encourage their sponsored ministries to infuse their mission in the life of the school to enable the graduates to take their rightful place in Church and society steeped in that mission. Cristo Rey Sacramento, sponsored by both the Jesuits and the Sisters of Mercy, found themselves in the unique position of juggling two missions and being accountable to two religious communities.

During the 2018-19 school year Mr. Timothy Caslin, *Associate Provincial Assistant for Secondary Education* for the Jesuits and Sr. Regina Ward, *Associate Director for Mission Integration* for Mercy Education System of the Americas, collaborated with Cristo Rey administration to look at the two missions in an integrated fashion. Their stewardship conversation now takes place jointly with both community representatives who encourage both the board chair and the school administration to frame their responses to the questions in an integrated Jesuit/Mercy or Mercy/Jesuit fashion. Without watering down either mission, the school will grow into a way of life that honors both.

This collaboration will enable CRHSS students to embrace both missions in a unified fashion as they embody the values presented to them throughout their high school career. What a rich legacy these students inherit!



