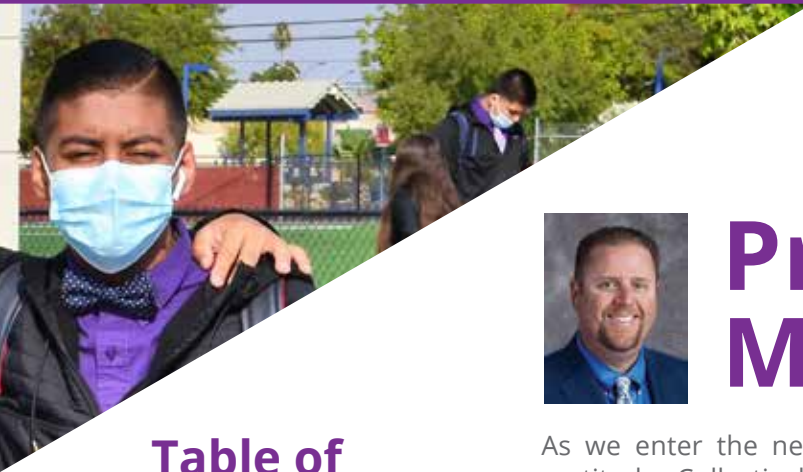
Our Mission

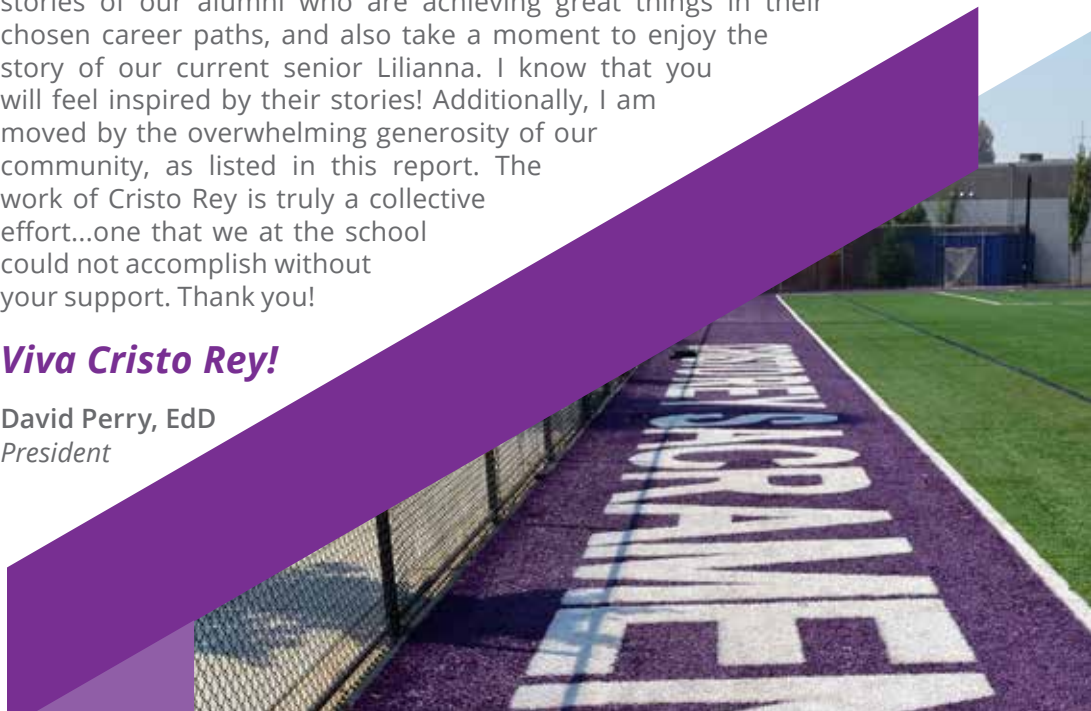
