Do you ever wonder how your contributions to Corpus Christi help:

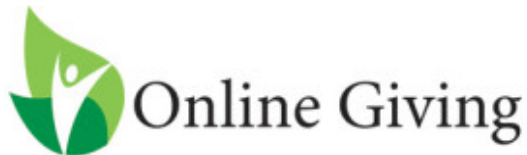
Pays staff salaries so that the ordained clergy have more time to visit the sick and comfort those who truly need to feel Jesus in their lives at this time.
