Thank you to our SPS community, the Hutton family, and our parents for making this day possible! We had a lot of fun and we learned many new things!








On Tuesday, December 5, our 8th Graders visited St. Mary's College High School in Berkeley, as they continue to anticipate their future after graduating from SPS.








